Commissioner Special Meeting Proceedings  
March 18, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 PM by Acting Chairman Corgatelli, with Commissioners Butts, and Clerk Lura Baker in attendance.

Commissioner Butts made a motion to go into Executive Session per Idaho Code 74-206 (1)(d) at 4:00 PM. Second Commissioner Corgatelli. Commissioners came out of Executive Session at 4:40 PM.

Commissioners conversed regarding several employees who have been out of the area where COVID-19 has been increasing. They requested those employees be asked to self-quarantine for the 14 days.

Commissioners discussed with the COVID-19 and the Governor's Proclamation declaring a state of emergency, it is necessary for the safety of the public and Custer County Employees that meetings will be handled with one commissioner at the place of meeting and the rest telephonically.

Commissioners requested Clerk Baker to notify all Elected Officials and Supervisors of the CDC Guidelines and to have their offices work on an appt basis. Hours can be adjusted for their office as necessary and those that can work remotely are encouraged to do so. The Supreme Court has sent out an Order for certain hearings that may be continued. All information will be placed on the doors of the Courthouse and on Custer County website.

Commissioners will meet on March 31<sup>st</sup> to re-evaluate the COVID-19 updates and Directives.
