

Custer County  
Commissioner Emergency Meeting Proceedings  
April 1, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 PM by Acting Chairman Butts, Commissioners Corgatelli, at the Courthouse, Challis Messenger Shelley Ridenour, Commissioner Steve Smith telephonically, and Clerk Lura Baker in attendance.

Commissioner Butts discussed reason for the Emergency Meeting today was because of the earthquake that took place on March 31, 2020. The Board will declare a Disaster Declaration to be in place in case there are facilities that will need assistance within Custer County.

Commissioner Corgatelli said he would get with Road & Bridge Supervisor to inspect the some of the bridges in Custer County. Jason from ITD District 6 has inspected bridges in his District and there is no noticed damage at this time. Calls have been coming in from other counties and as far as Washington DC offering any assistance Custer County may need.

Shelley inquired if there were any buildings at this time that has been affected by the earthquake. Commissioner Smith explained there are cracks in the cinder blocks at the Road & Bridge Shop as well as older cracks in Courthouse becoming more visible.

Commissioner Corgatelli made a motion to adopt Resolution 2020-04 Disaster Declaration resulting in damage to property after the March 31, 2020 earthquake and any aftershocks. Second Commissioner Smith. Roll call vote 3 ayes.

With no further business before the board, the meeting was adjourned at 1:15 P.M.
