## Custer County Public Hearing January 14, 2019

Meeting was called to order 5:03 p.m. present Commissioner Smith, Commissioner Corgatelli, Clerk Lura Baker, Deputy Tina Hawkins and Planning & Zoning Administrator Christy Foster.

Vice-Chair Commissioner Smith read the recommendations of the Planning & Zoning Board.

Commissioner Smith read the changes or updates to Zoning Ordinance 2007-09 as follows;

Article II, Sec B: Add the word "Commercial" to the term "Sand, Gravel, and Road Filled Extraction"

Delete the term and definition of "Quarry"

Replace the term "Industrial, Extractive" with "Mineral Extraction"

Article VI, Official Schedule of District Regulations: "Mineral Extraction" to require a Conditional Use Permit under all land use groups.

"Commercial - Sand, Gravel, and Road Filled Extraction" to require a Conditional Use Permit for all land use groups.

Add the term "Private - Sand, Gravel, and Road Filled Extraction" and use be permitted under Transitional Agricultural and Agricultural.

Delete the term and use "Mineral Extraction/Mining"

Article VII Sec. D(8)(b): Add "The area will be reclaimed to no less than a 2:1 slope. All setbacks to be considered on a case by case basis."

No one was in the audience to give testimony.

Commissioner Smith asked if there were any objections to the changes. There being none, Ordinance 2019-01, making changes to Zoning Ordinance 2007-09, was passed unanimously.

The Public Hearing was then adjourned at 5:07 p.m.
