

Custer County
Public Hearing Proceedings
August 12, 2019

The Custer County Board of Commissioners met at 5:02 PM for an advertised and posted Public Hearing for Resolution 2019-06 setting the fee for corrugated cardboard at the Custer County Solid Waste Transfer Sites at .064 cents per pound. Commissioners Wayne F. Butts, Steve Smith and Randy Corgatelli were all in attendance. Also attending were Deputy Clerk Tina Hawkins and Wendell Gohn with Blue Mountain Refuse.

The Board of Commissioners heard Wendell Gohn's explanation of the need for this fee to cover the expense of handling cardboard. He is unable to sell the cleaned, baled cardboard to recyclers any longer. The last load he shipped out was for free, the hauler took it for nothing just to make room in his storage area. Wendell will move the cardboard recycle trailer beyond the scale inside the solid waste site. The clean sorted cardboard will still be baled and shipped out for recycling when possible. If patrons do not care to sort it, they can leave it with their other trash and it will be hauled to the landfill with the other garbage. The Blue Mountain Refuse crew will not be digging it out of the dumpsters.

Commissioner Corgatelli asked for verification on the fee of .064 cents per pound. Wendell verified that that was correct. The subject will be taken under advisory until the August 28th Commissioners meeting to be completed with a motion at that time. The effective date of this fee change will be September 1st, 2019. Chairman Wayne Butts thanked Wendell for his attendance knowledge and comments.

The Public Hearing was adjourned at 5:14 P.M.
