

Custer County
Commissioner Special Meeting Proceedings
Budget Workshop
July 17, 2023

The meeting was called to order at 11:00 AM in the Custer County Board Room by Vice Chairman Randy Corgatelli with Commissioners Steve Smith, Clerk Lura Baker, CEDA Director Jolie Turek and Custer Telephone Manager J.D. Bennetts in attendance.

Commissioner Smith made a motion to go into executive session under Title 74-206(1)(b) for Personnel at 11:01 AM Commissioner Corgatelli seconded the motion and the roll call vote was unanimous Aye. Attending were Commissioner Smith, Commissioner Corgatelli, Jolie Turek, J.D. Bennetts and Clerk Lura Baker. No decisions were made during this session, and the board returned to regular session at 11:10 AM.

The percentage of federal land within all counties in Idaho will be sent to Jolie for her information. The meeting was recessed for lunch and reconvened at 12:00 PM.

After researching, it was verified that the land under Redfish Lake is owned by the Idaho Department of Lands. A meeting of the Custer Waterways Committee will be set up to assist with the development of a MOU.

A Liquor License application from Lost River Disco for a three-day catering permit was received. Commissioner Smith moved the application be approved. Commissioner Corgatelli seconded and the motion passed. A liquor license catering permit for one-day was received from C K Miller/Mountain Springs Ranch. Commissioner Smith moved the application be approved. Commissioner Corgatelli seconded and the motion carried. A liquor license application was received from the Stanley Baking Company. Commissioner Smith moved it be approved. Commissioner Corgatelli seconded the motion and it passed. A liquor license application was received from the Oasis Stop & Go, LLC. Commissioner Smith moved it to be approved. Commissioner Corgatelli seconded and the motion carried. The liquor license application from Riveria Quick Trip LLC was then reviewed. Commissioner Smith moved it be approved. Commissioner Corgatelli seconded the motion and it passed. The final liquor license application was received from Stinker Store Inc. Commissioner Smith moved it be approved, Commissioner Corgatelli seconded the motion and it passed.

The Budget Workshop then commenced.

With no further business before the board, the meeting was adjourned at 3:00 P.M.
