

Custer County
Special Meeting Proceedings
January 13, 2023

The Special Meeting was called to order at 4:00 PM in the Custer County Commissioners Room. Attending the meeting were Commissioner Chairman Wayne Butts, Commissioner Steve Smith, Commissioner Randy Corgatelli, Prosecutor Justin Oleson, Clerk Lura Baker and Deputy Clerk Tina Hawkins

Commissioner Corgatelli made a motion to go into executive session under Title 74-206(1)(i) for Prevention of Claim at 4:02 PM. Commissioner Smith seconded the motion and the roll call vote was unanimous Aye. Attending were Commissioner Smith, Commissioner Butts, Commissioner Corgatelli, Prosecutor Justin Oleson, Clerk Lura Baker and Deputy Clerk Tina Hawkins. No decisions were made during this session, and the board returned to regular session at 4:35 PM.

The proposed jail design was gone over and discussed. Bingham County is currently building a jail and Commissioner Smith will contact them with his questions. Commissioner Corgatelli will contact Kerion Donahue at Canyon County with his questions. Sheriff Stu Lumpkin will be contacted by Commissioner Butts.

The Court Annex design was discussed and the newest drawings were reviewed. A survey of the 106' by 106' lot has been done, so the final floor plan will be adjusted to fit within the setback requirements. The space and design of the rooms were reviewed and changes noted.

Jail contingency plans were then looked over to make the best possible use of the funds available. Comparisons were made of different possibilities and each option was discussed.

Everyone was thanked for attending and the meeting was adjourned at 5:15 PM.
